Positive verdict for N05-A gas production project

Today, the Dutch Council of State (Raad van State) has ruled that ONE-Dyas can continue the offshore activities on gas production project N05-A. Delivery of the first natural gas in December 2024 is therefore still possible.

On 4 June 2024, the Council of State suspended the permit for offshore operations in the North Sea, following a request for a preliminary injunction by opponents of the project. During the hearing on 12 June 2024, the preliminary injunction judge listened to and assessed the arguments of opponents, the Ministry of Economic Affairs and Climate as well as ONE-Dyas. In today's ruling, he indicated that he saw no reason to suspend offshore activities pending the outcome of the appeal, which will be scheduled at a date yet to be set. No appeal is possible against this decision of the Council of State and therefore ONE-Dyas can immediately proceed with its planned activities in the North Sea.
